Declaration of Homestead

E. E. Phillips

I, E. E. Phillips know all men by these presents That I am a single man and the head of a family and at the time of making this declaration residing with my said family upon the premises described as follows to wit That certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in Eureka County state

of Nevada on the Easterly side of Spring street and near
 the corner of Clark street in said town and known and
 designated on the Map of the Monroe Survey of said town
 as Lot No. 31 two in Block 112, having front Twenty
 five feet front & one hundred 1100 feet deep. That it is my
 intention to hold and claim the same together with the tenem-
 ents and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise ap-
 pertaining thereto as a Homestead under and by virtue of the
 provisions of an act of the Legislature of the state of Nevada ent-
 itled an act to exempt the Homestead and other property
 from forced sale in certain cases. Approved March 6th 1865
 and other acts amendatory and supplemental thereto.
