Declaration of Homestead

E. C. Phillips

I, E. C. Phillips of Coconino Coconino County state of
Arizona, am a married man and the head of a family
and, at the time of making this declaration residing
with my said family upon the premises described as
follows to wit: That certain piece of parcel of land situate
lying and being in Coconino Coconino County state

of Nevada on the Eastern side of Spring Street and near
 the corner of Clark Street in said town and known and
 designated on the Map of the Monroe Survey of said town
 as Lot No (2) two in Block (12) twelve and being (25) Twenty
 five feet front & one hundred four feet deep. That it is my
 intention to hold and claim the same together with the tenem-
 ents and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise app-
 ertaining thereto as a Homestead under and by virtue of the
 provisions of an act of the Legislature of the state of Nevada ent-
 itled an act to exempt the Homestead and other property
 from forced sale in certain cases Approved March 6th 1865
 and other acts amendatory and supplemental thereto.
