Agreement

A. E. O'Neil

This agreement made and entered into this 22nd day of April A.D. 1873. Between Edward Cannon of the first part and A. E. O'Neil the party of the second part Witnesseth the party of the first part in consideration of the Covenants and Agreements of the party of the second part as hereinafter set forth Covenants and agrees that upon the payment to him of the sum of Two Thousand (\$2000) Gold Coin of the United States by the party of the second part the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged and upon the receipt of the further sum of Three Thousand Eight Hundred (\$3800) Dollars Gold Coin of the United States he will by good and sufficient deed within the time hereinafter named sell and convey to the party of the second part all his right, title and interest in and to one hundred (100) feet or that certain mining claim in Escambia Mining District Escambia County State of Florida known and recorded as the "Jenkinsville" situated on a spur of prospect Mountain near the mining claim known as the Dunderberg in consideration of which the party of the second part hereby agrees to pay to the party of the first part the sum of Three Thousand Eight Hundred (\$3800) Dollars in Gold Coin of the United States on or before three months from the date hereof unless during such time dispute or litigation occur in relation to the title of said "Jenkinsville" Mine, then said sum of Three Thousand Eight Hundred (\$3800) Dollars Gold Coin shall be paid by the party of the second part whenever such dispute or litigation shall be settled and it is mutually agreed between the parties hereto that the party of the second part shall pending the time herein named have the possession of said Mine and a right to work the same and the ore therefrom shall be for his own use and benefit provided he shall make or cause to be made no debts against said mine and further in case the payment herein mentioned is not made then this agreement to be void and the party of the second part released from liability thereon Witness our hands and seals this 22nd day of April A.D. 1873.
