Articles of Agreement made and entered into this eighth day of July A.D. One thousand eight hundred and seventy three by and between Frank M. Moaine of the town of Eureka, County of Eureka, and State of Nevada, party of the first part, and M. P. Murphy of the said town of Eureka, County of Eureka, and State of Nevada, party of the second part, Witnesseth:

That whereas the said party of the first being desirous of purchasing the undivided four hundred (400) feet of that certain Mine Mining claim, or location known as and called the "Confidence Ledge and Co." situated and being on Jackson Hill in the Eureka Mining District in said County of Eureka and State of Nevada, and lying between the "Carson" on the north and the "Adams and Farrow" on the south and which said Mine Mining claim, or location, containing One thousand (1000) feet in all, and was located on or about the 17th day of December A.D. 1869 by M. Hartnett & J. Sullivan, M. Murphy, and W. Crowley, did on the

7th day of July A.D. 1878 enter into a written contract with one William Hartnett, the lawful owner and holder of an undivided Four hundred (400) feet in the above described Mine, Mining Claim or location, by the terms of which said written contract, the said party of the first part was on ~~and~~ before the 7th day of September A.D. 1873, to purchase said undivided Four hundred (400) feet and the said William Hartnett was on the payment of a certain sum named in said written contract, to convey said Four hundred (400) feet undivided, in said above described Mine, Mining Claim or location, to the party of the first part hereto on or before the said 7th day of September A.D. 1873 by good and sufficient Deed of bargain and sale.

And whereas the said party of the second part is the lawful owner and holder of an undivided Two hundred (200) feet in the above described Mine, Mining Claim or location.



And whereas the said parties of the first and second part to these presents are mutually desirous of selling and disposing of their respective interests of in and to the said above described Mine, Mining Claim or location, on the most advantageous terms and for the best price that can be obtained therefor:

Agree therefore in consideration of the premises it is hereby mutually covenanted and agreed by and between the parties hereto that they will each use all reasonable effort to sell and dispose of their interests in said Mine, Mining Claim or location together and not separately, and that in the event of either party or both making such sale or other disposition of their said interests that then the proceeds of such sale or other disposition of their said interests shall be shared by the parties to these presents share and share alike independent of the value of the respective interests held by each in said Mine, Mining Claim or location: that is to say, the proceeds of such sale or disposition of their interests in said Mine, Mining Claim or location shall be divided equally, to the party of the first part one half, and to the said party of the second part one half.

And it is hereby in consideration of the premises mutually covenanted and agreed by and between the parties to these presents, that the said party of the first part shall have full power to sell or dispose of the interests of the parties of first and second part hereto, of in and to the said above described Mine, Mining Claim or location without let or hindrance from the said party of the second part: but that the said party of the second

part. shall not sell or dispose of said interest in said Mine, Mining Claim, or Location, without the full and entire consent of said party of the first part, first had and obtained.
