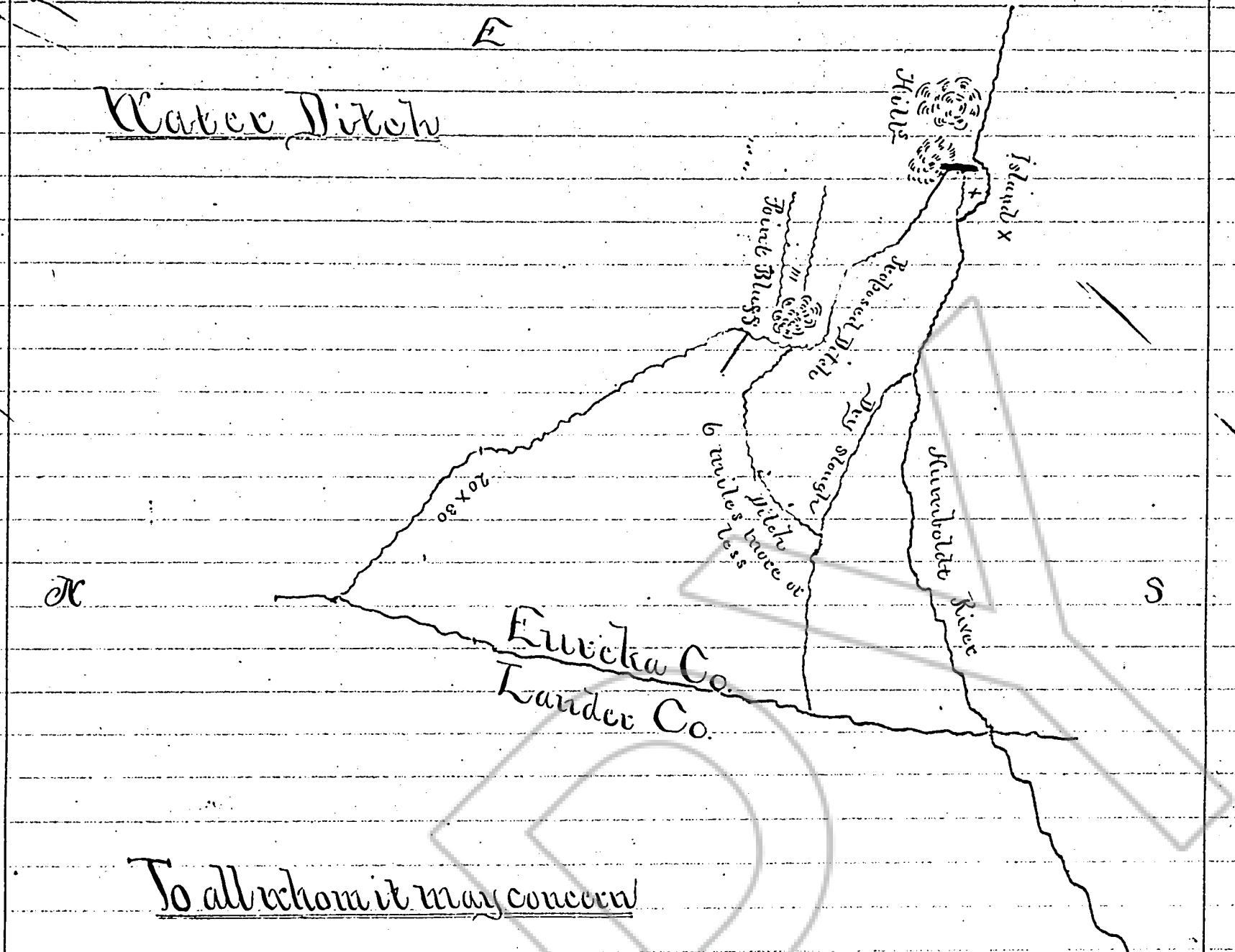


Water Ditch



To all whom it may concern

Notice is hereby given, that J. J. Row, a citizen of the United States, and of Eureka County, State of Nevada, has claimed all the waters of Humboldt River, located in the said County of Eureka, for the purpose of a Ditch or Canal to be used for irrigation and Agricultural purposes

- 1<sup>st</sup> The Ditch is to be known as the Shoshone Canal
- 2<sup>d</sup> The waters to be taken out of said River on the North Side and near a small Reef, Three miles, more or less, up the river from Shoshone Ditch, and the further use of said Dry Slough for segregating of said water

And for further notice, see plat of proposed Ditch and Water Course hereby annexed, located by the mention of a Rock Mound, and notice, and I hereby certify that I do not know of any other location, above or below that Mound be injured by the same. Dated this 4<sup>th</sup> day of July 1873
