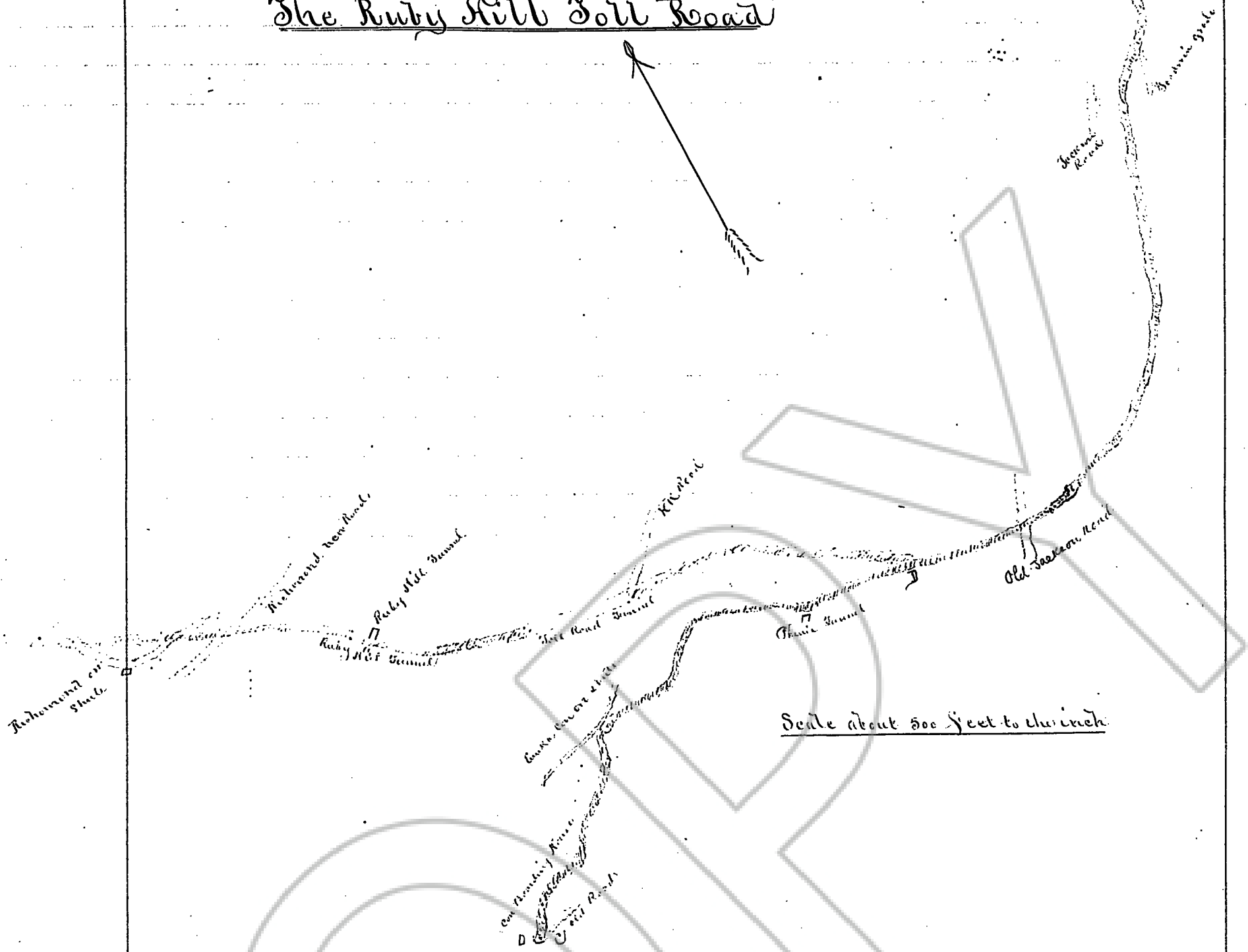

Descriptive Details of
The Ruby Hill Toll Road



Ruby Hill Toll Road, Eureka County Nevada
(Middle Division)

Know all men by these presents, that J. J. Adams, of San Jose Santa Clara County, State of California and of Eureka County State of Nevada, do on this 29th day of July 1873, through my Attorney in fact J. D. Emurley, also of said Eureka County, claim the right under laws in force in said State of Nevada to build and maintain a Toll Road, which is to be known by the above name as also to collect such Tolls thereon as the law may allow. The plat attached hereto indicates the location and course of the middle division of said Ruby Hill Toll Road, the initial point marked A, being a stake north west of the Richmond ore shute on the eastern slope of Ruby Hill, near the Silver Region Mining Claim. Its course is thence easterly, across both branches of the Richmond New Grade and curves around the Hill above, and close to the entrance of the Ruby Hill Summit, thence along the slope of Marcellus ravine, till it crosses it at stake bot of United States Mining survey No 56 and enters a tunnel 300 ft in length to be cut through the ridge between said Ravine and the summit N. K. Road. From the latter point the grade continues along the north easterly base of Ajax Hill, across the old Jackson Road, and turns northerly between it and the Goodwin Grade, until it reaches B at the south end of Quabby Mountain. The distance being about 7000 feet.

The south westerly branch of said Fall Road (Middle Division) begins at W. alongside the Consolidated Boarding House on Ruby Hill, and extends North & North Easterly past the point where the road from the N N Mine enters the gulch. East of Marcellena ravine. thence Wind & around the face of Ajax Hill in an Easterly direction past the mouth of Phoenix Tunnel and joins the Richmond Branch of the Road at 10 east of said Tunnel the distance from 6 to 10, being about 2600 feet. While the entire extent of both branches of said Middle Division is as indicated by the plat, about one (1) & eight tenths of a mile. The undersigned reserves to himself the right, through his said atty. to vary the course of the road somewhat according as future requirements and the nature of the ground may render advisable.
