This Agreement made and entered into this 15<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1873, between Henry Gardin, John Helgeson & W. E. Shonack Parties of the first part, and Thos. J. Taylor of the Town of Eureka, County of Eureka, Nevada Party of the second part. Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part found in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter stated to be done and performed by the party of the second part, hereby agrees that the said Thomas J. Taylor party of the second part shall have an equal <sup>interest</sup> with each of them in all moneys arising either from the working or sale of a certain Mining Claim Situate in Eureka Mining District Eureka Co. Nevada located the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June 1870 and known as the "Pleades Mine" said interest to be equal to one fourth of the net proceeds of said mine either from work-

or the sale of the same. The Party of the Second part hereby agrees to furnish the sum of Two thousand and fifty (\$250) Dollars United States Gold Coin to be expended by W. E. Stonach in the opening up and development of said Mining Claim aforesaid and further to use his best efforts in effecting the sale of the said Mine at such a price as may be agreed upon by the parties hereto. It is further mutually agreed and understood by and between the parties hereto that in case of the profitable working or sale of said Mine that any monies advanced for the purpose of opening said mine by either of the parties hereto shall be refunded to the party advancing the same before any division of said money. Or in other words only the net balance after paying for all labor and expense incurred in opening said Mine or legitimately incurred in effecting a sale of the same - shall be equally divided between the parties hereto that is to say One fourth of said net sum to Oly Jardine One fourth to John Helgeson. One fourth to W. E. Stonach and One fourth to Thomas J. Taylor.
