between

John Oriesbach

and
John S Neel

This agreement made & entered into this 29 day of July 1873 between John Oriesbach of Eureka Eureka County State of Nevada party of the first part and John S Neel of Carson City State aforesaid party of the second part. Witnesseth, that whereas the

said party of the first part did on or about the 29 day of July 1873 sell and convey to said party of the second part an undivided One Eighth ($\frac{1}{8}$) of that certain mining claim situated in Eureka Mining District in said County and State and known as & called the "Fourth of July"

And whereas there now remains unpaid of the purchase money the sum of One thousand and Eighty nine & 50/100 Dollars U S gold coin (\$1089 $\frac{50}{100}$) Now therefore the said party of the second part in consideration of said conveyance and for the purpose of securing the payment of the balance of said purchase money hereby agrees that said party of the first part shall have the right and he is hereby authorized and empowered to take

from the first proceeds of the working or sale of the interest of said party of the second part aforesaid said sum of \$1089 + until the same is fully paid and satisfied the same shall constitute a lien upon said interest of said party of the second part.
