above named defendant, to quiet the title
to the Mining ground and premises in the
Complaint in the said action and hereinafter
described and to determine all and every claim
estate or interest therein of said defendant
adverse to the said plaintiff and that the
premises affected by this suit are situated
in the Eureka Mining District in the County
and State aforesaid and are bounded and
described as follows, to wit: "An undivided
three fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$) interest in each of those certain
Mining Claim rights and locations known as
and called the 'Counely Ledge' and 'Counely
No 2' and further known and held as one
and the same claim under the name of the
'Counely Ledge' commencing at the initial pin
