George A. Sayre

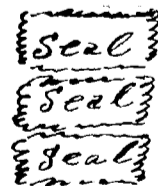
Articles of agreement made
and entered into this Eleventh day of November A.D. 1873
By and between L. D. Pope and B. E. Ball both of
Esmeralda County State of Nevada parties of the first
part and George A. Sayre of the same place
party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said
parties of the first part for and in consideration
of the sum of Six hundred (\$600.00) Dollars to them
in hand paid by the said party of the second part
the receipt whereof they hereby acknowledge and
of the further consideration of the covenants and
agreements of the said party of the second part
hereinafter set forth do hereby covenant promise
and agree to and with the said party of the
second part that they and each of them will
and they and each of them hereby do cancel
and annul and make void so far as their or
either of their rights and privileges thereunder
are concerned all of the conditions of a certain
contract or agreement now of Record in said
Esmeralda County wherein the parties of the first part
herein are named as the parties of the first part
and the party of the second part herein is named
as the party of the second part, said agreement
being dated July 1st 1873 and concerns and
affects that certain Mine known and described
as the "Little Rosa" Mine situate lying and

being on "Horsac" or "Bald" Mountain in Eureka Mining District Eureka County State of Nevada, containing in all fifteen hundred (1500) feet undivided. Located by the said George A. Sayre on the 4th day of August A.D. 1872 and Recorded in the Mining Records of said Eureka Mining District Eureka (then Lander) County Nevada in Book "E" page 69 on the 8th day of August A.D. 1872 and further that they and each of them will and hereby do release the said party of the second part from all liabilities and obligations under or by virtue of any and all of the covenants of said agreement and will and hereby do release set over assign and transfer all of their and each of their rights privileges and benefits arising from under or by virtue of said agreement to the said party of the second part and they and each of them do hereby release the said above named and described mine from any and all operation of the said agreement or any of the covenants thereof, as fully to all intents and purposes as if said agreement had never been entered into. And the said party of the second part in consideration of the above and foregoing covenants and agreements of the said parties of the first part doth hereby covenant, promise and agree to pay to the said parties of the first part in addition to the said sum of Six Hundred Dollars hereinbefore mentioned the further sum of four hundred (\$400.00) Dollars in gold coin at any time when one M. S. Hayes buys and pays for the above named and described mine in accordance with his agreement heretofore made: within five months from the date hereof

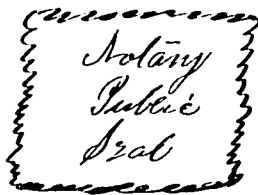
