

Agreement
between
W. H. Clark
and
W. A. Seaton

Articles of Agreement made and entered into the first day of November A.D. 1873 between W. H. Clark of the first part and W. A. Seaton of the second part both of Churchill County of Nevada and State of Nevada. Whereas the said parties have by mutual consent dissolved the mercantile and trading copartnership heretofore existing between them and are desirous of making an amicable arrangement in relation to the assets and liabilities of said Copartnership Now this agreement. Witnesseth That it is hereby agreed between said parties that the said W. A. Seaton for his share of the property and assets of said firm shall have and hold the live stock and stock ranch belonging thereto. Also the house and lot now occupied in Churchill by the said W. A. Seaton. Also the two lots in said town now standing in the name of the said W. A. Seaton and the horse buggy and harness. And that the said W. H. Clark for his share of said property and assets shall have and hold all

and singular the assets and property not herein before enumerated including the Stone Store on the South West corner of Main and Clark Streets in said Town of Eureka and the Stock of goods wares and merchandise therein contained with the notes and book accounts due and to become due to said firm, also the Ditch Wood Ranch and Toll Road of said firm in said County and a piece of property situated in the State of Iowa In consideration whereof the said W. A. Clark hereby agrees and undertakes to assume and pay all the debts and liabilities of the said late firm of Seaton & Company.

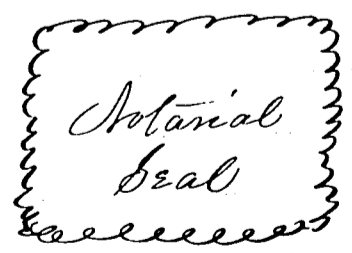
