Confession of Judgment.

J. W. Ellyson of Eureka Eureka County State of Nevada
Defendant in the above entitled action do hereby confess
judgment therein in favor of the said Plaintiff L. J.
Hogle for the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars
gold coin of the United States and authorize judgment
to be rendered against me therefor with interest at the
rate of ten per cent per month upon the sum of two
hundred dollars payable in like coin from this date
until paid. This confession of judgment is for a
debt due and owing from me to the said Plaintiff
having to do and owing upon my certain promissory
note made executed and delivered to the said Plaintiff
which is in words and figures as follows to wit:
\$200. Palisade June 31. 1872. Forty days after date with-
out grace for value received I promise to pay L. J.
Hogle or order the sum of two hundred dollars
in United States gold coin with interest at the rate
of ten (10) per cent per month until paid payable
monthly in like gold coin. J. W. Ellyson. That
upon said note I have never paid or caused to be
paid any sum of money either principal or interest
and that there is now due to the said Plaintiff
who is still the holder and owner of said note the
sum of two hundred dollars gold coin principal
and three hundred and fifty dollars gold coin
interest up to this date accrued thereon.

Ellyson.

Now therefore in view of the law and the facts it is ordered adjudged and decreed that Plaintiff do have judgment against the defendant for the sum of two hundred dollars the amount of the promissory note described in their confession in United States gold coin and for the further sum of three hundred and fifty dollars in like gold coin to date and for interest on the sum of two hundred dollars at the rate of ten per cent per month gold coin from this date until paid and for costs taxed at \$9.00
