Notice is hereby given
That I Eliakim Cory of Esmeralda County
aforesaid, the undersigned do hereby
locate and appropriate all the water now remaining issuing
and flowing or which may hereafter issue or flow or run from
that certain Spring situated in the Esmeralda Mining District
County and State aforesaid and particularly described as being
located in "Hamburg Ravine" about four hundred yards
above the "Friday Ravine" and about two hundred (200) feet
east from the "Hamburg Mine" and at the foot of Peckstick
Hill which Spring is known as Cory Spring and was
discovered by me on the 1st of October 1873 and upon which
I have sunk a shaft fifteen (15) feet deep and have started
a cut to tap the water in said Spring. I claim the right to
divert and conduct the water from said Spring to any suitable
point by means of Ditches Flumes or other appliances
in accordance with the laws of this State to be complied with
hereafter and the rights and privileges which are guar-
anteed to first appropriators of Water. I further claim
and do hereby locate and appropriate a sufficient quantity of the
Public Domain in and about said Spring for the
convenient use and enjoyment of the right herein claimed
Esmeralda Nevada October 1. 1873.
