Notice is hereby given
 That I Eliakim Cory of Esmeralda County aforesaid the un-
 designed do hereby locate and appropriate all the water
 now running issuing and flowing or which may here-
 after issue or flow or run from that certain Spring
 situated in the Esmeralda Mining District County and
 State aforesaid and particularly described as being
 located in "Friday Ravine" four and one half (4 1/2) miles
 South West from the Town of Esmeralda and about Two
 Hundred feet east from the "Friday Mine" and at the
 foot of Red Rock Hill. Which Spring of Water was
 discovered by me on the 15th of September A.D. 1842
 while sinking a shaft - at the depth of fifteen (15) feet
 from the surface and since which discovery I have run
 a Tunnel a distance of 150 feet to said Spring from which
 the water therefrom is now flowing. Said Spring is known
 by the name of the "Cory Spring" I claim the right
 to divert and conduct the water from said Spring
 to any accessible point by means of Ditches Flumes
 or other appliances in accordance with the laws
 of this State to be complied with hereafter and
 the rights and privileges which are guaranteed to
 first first appropriators of Water. I further claim
 and do hereby locate and appropriate a sufficient
 quantity of the Public Domain in and around and
 about said Spring for the convenient use and
 enjoyment of the right herein claimed.
