Contract of Lease.

Known all men by these presents that the Pamuchill Silver Mining Company, a corporation under the laws of the State of New York through their Attorney in fact, W. H. Griffith, has this day leased and demised unto Jos W. Killien and William Head both of Eureka, Nevada, all those certain mining claims, rights and locations, now belonging to said Corporation, situated in New York Canon in the Eureka Mining District and known and designated as Keystone, Hunter, Fairville Eureka, Dorrisville, California and Virginia Mines, for the period of six months from the 1st instant: the said Killien and Head to have full power and authority to work, control and manage the said mines, as they, exercising proper discretion may deem best, provided always that the said mining property shall be worked without any charge to the Company Corporation; And the said Killien and Head covenant to faithfully account for all the ore taken out of said mines, and after paying for hauling said ore to the place or places where the same shall be sold, together with all taxes and assessments upon the same, to pay over

to said Griffith, attorney in fact aforesaid the
 one fifth part of the proceeds at which the said
 ores shall be sold. And the said Killie & Head
 further covenant that they will deliver possession
 of said mines at the expiration of this lease,

the mines whereof the said parties hereto
 have heretofore interchangeably put their
 hands this first day of November 1873.
