Articles of Separation

This Agreement made and entered into this present day of March in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Seventy four By and Between Thomas Conner of Cowdell County and State of Nevada of the one part and Anna Conner of said County and State of the other part. Witnesseth That whereas upon the First day of January Anno Domini 1873. The said Thomas Conner and Anna Conner were joined in Matrimony and said parties have ever since lived together as husband and Wife; And whereas by Mutual Consent and Solemn agreement the said Thomas and Anna Conner have agreed to an immediate separation without the intervention of a Court or any decree of divorce: Now therefore in consideration of said agreement of Separation as above specified the said parties hereto doth both and each for himself and herself agree to live separate and apart thence forth and forever the same as though the relationship of husband and wife never existed between them. That all the Community property of the said parties hereto, of whatsoever kind or nature obtained since their said marriage is, and the same is hereby vested in the said Thomas Conner free from any claim or interest either legal or equitable on the part of said Anna Conner on account of said relationship in or to said property, and from and after the date of these Articles of Separation the said Anna Conner is to have and exercise all the privileges of a Single-Sole, to contract debts in and upon her own account and have the right to sue and be sued in her own name, in the same manner as though said marriage relation never existed, and from and after this date the said Anna Conner is to be personally liable and responsible for all debts contracted by her, and the same or no portion thereof are to be charged against said Thomas Conner or against his property, and in the event said parties hereto shall again consent to live together as husband and Wife the liability of said Thomas Conner for the Maintenance of said Anna Conner shall only begin from the date of such consent and the actual revocation of these Articles of Separation. The Children of said Anna Conner by a former husband are to be and remain with the said Anna Conner during their said separation, and the said Anna Conner is alone chargeable with their support.

and shall have entire and exclusive control over
 them and entitled to all of their earnings, with the
 exception of the second youngest Nettie Louren
 aged 11 years, which child is to be taken care of and
 educated by said Thomas Coum in any school he see
 designated in California, and to inform the said
 Anna Coum of whereabouts until she arrives at the
 age of maturity in this agreement designated at
 eighteen years.
