We the undersigned have this day claimed, located and hereby take possession of this Spring of Water, claiming all the water in said Spring, all that may flow into said Springs as well as Water that may hereafter flow or run from said Spring. We also claim the right to conduct this Water in Pipes or Channels most convenient for our uses and purposes.

This Spring is situated at mouth of Cañon about twelve miles North Westly from the Town of Eureka and at a point about one mile Westly from the Survey line of the Eureka and Palisade Railroad which said line to be defined by commencing at Pritchards First Stage Station North from Eureka, and running said defining line in a Westly direction. This Spring to be known named and recorded as "Railroad Spring"
