Spring Location.

Notice is hereby given that we Isaac Whisler, J. H. Reece ^{and} P. J. Demant of Esmeralda County aforesaid, the undersigned do hereby locate and appropriate all the water issuing and flowing, or which may hereafter issue from or run from that certain Spring situated in Esmeralda County State of Nevada and particularly described as being located about one half (1/2) mile Southwesterly upon side of Hill from "Mud Spring". This Spring to be known as "Gravel Bottom" Spring. We claim the right to divert and conduct the water from said Spring to any accessible point, by means of ditches flumes or other appliances, in accordance with the laws of this State, and of the Laws of the United States, to be completed with hereafter, ^{and} the rights and privileges, which are guaranteed to first appropriators of water. We further claim and do hereby locate and appropriate a sufficient quantity of the Public Domain in, around and about said Spring for the convenient use and enjoyment of the right herein claimed.
