Notice is hereby given that we Isaac Whittle, J. H. Rice, and J. J. Dumant of Eureka County aforesaid, the undersigned do hereby locate and appropriate all the water issuing <sup>and flowing</sup> or which may hereafter issue, flow, or run from that certain Spring situated in Eureka County State of Nevada and particularly described as being located about one half mile Southwesterly from "Wass Lake Springs" on the Richmond Ranch, this Spring known as "Ox Mine" Spring.

We claim the right to divert and conduct the water from said Spring to any accessible point by means of ditches, flumes, or other appliances in accordance with the laws of this State, or the laws of the United States, to be complied with hereafter, and the rights and privileges which are guaranteed to first appropriators of water. We further claim and do hereby locate and appropriate a sufficient quantity of the Public Domain in, around, <sup>and</sup> about said Spring for the convenient use and enjoyment of the rights herein claimed.
