Spring Location.

Notice is hereby given that we Isaac Whisler, J. H. Rice ^{and} J. J. Bennett of Eureka County aforesaid, the undersigned do hereby locate and appropriate all the water issuing ^{and} flowing, or which may hereafter issue, from, or run from that certain Spring situated in Eureka County State of Nevada, ^{and} particularly described as being located about Twelve Miles Northwesterly from the Town of Eureka, and about Two hundred yards Southerly from Reservoir Springs. This Spring known as "Mud Spring".

We claim the right to divert ^{and} conduct the water from said Spring to any accessible point by means of ditches, flumes, or other appliances in accordance with the laws of this State and the laws of the United States, to be completed with hereafter, and the rights ^{and} privileges, which are guaranteed to first appropriators of water. We further claim, ^{and} do hereby locate and appropriate a sufficient quantity of the Public Domain in, around, and about said Spring, for the convenient use and enjoyment of the right herein claimed.
