This Agreement made the 29th day of
December in the year of our Lord one
thousand, Eight Hundred and seventy four
Between F. Rigelhuth of the Town and

County of Eureka State of Nevada of the first part and
P.P. Esterly of the same place the party of the second part
Witnesseth. That the said party of the first part in considera-
tion of the covenants, promises and agreements on the part
of the said party of the second part hereinafter contained
covenants, promises and agrees to and with the said party
of the second part that the said party of the first part will
and is hereby authorized to collect sue for demands and
receive all debts accounts dues claims and credits due
or to become due to the parties hereto of or from the
business heretofore conducted by them as partners in the
Saloon and Dance House business. on Buell St. Lot No 5 in
Block 7 of the Monroe Survey of said Town of Eureka.
And the said party of the second part in consideration
the said covenants promises and agreements on the part of the said
party of the first part hereinbefore contained covenanted, promised
and agreed to and with the said party of the first part that
the said party of the second part will pay all debts
and claims against the parties hereto that have or may accrue
in conducting the said Saloon & Dance House business
at the places aforesaid and will hold the party of the second
partners from all costs fees and damages by reason of
said business. And it is hereby mutually agreed that the
partnership heretofore existing between the parties hereto under
the name of Esterly and Rigelhuth in the business aforesaid
is this day dissolved by mutual consent. And it is expressly
understood that the covenants promises and agreements herein
contained shall apply to bind the heirs Executors and
administrators of the respective parties. And for the true
and faithful performance of all and every of the said
covenants promises and agreements. the said parties to these
presents bind themselves each unto the other in the sum of
Five Hundred dollars in gold coin of the United
States of America as fixed settled and liquidated damage
to be paid by the failing party.
