Bill of Sale.

sum of Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250⁰⁰) dollars, Gold Coin of the
United States of America, to him in hand paid by Ming See of the
Town of Ruby Hill, County and State aforesaid the party of the
second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have
granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said party of the
second part, his executors, administrators, and assigns, a
certain Chinese Wash House situated on Ruby Hill, said County
and State, said Wash House being situated on the main
Street of said Town of Ruby Hill, also all the Washing Utensils
and every thing now contained in said Wash House.

I have and to hold the same to the said party of the
second part, his executors, administrators, and assigns for
ever. And I do for myself, my heirs, executors, and adminis-
trators, covenant and agree to and with the said party of the
second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, to war-
rant and defend the sale of the said property, goods, and
chattels hereby made unto the said party of the second part,
his executors, administrators and assigns, against all and
every person and persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming,
or to claim the same.
