Articles of Separation

This Indenture made and entered into this 23^d day of June 1875 by and between D. H. Hall of the town of Eureka County of Eureka and State of Nevada party of the first part and Agnes Hall his wife of the same place the party of the second part Witnesseth. That whereas the said parties to these presents were on the 4th day of July 1864 at the town of Austin in Lander County and State of Nevada duly and legally married since which time they have lived and cohabited together as husband and wife and whereas said parties are the owners of certain Common Property in said town and County of Eureka and whereas the said parties mutually wish to separate as husband and wife and from this time hereafter and forever to cease living and cohabiting together as husband and wife

Now in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants and agreements hereby made and entered into and of three thousand dollars gold coin of the United States to him in hand paid said party of the first part does hereby solemnly promise covenant and agree to and with said party of the second part that he will pay all of his individual debts and that from the date of these presents henceforth and forever he does hereby relinquish all right and claim of whatever nature or kind to or over the person and company of his said wife and he does hereby give and convey all of his claim and right of whatever nature or kind possession or control of all Common Property. Except contents of safe. Except liquors owned in common and of all estate title or interest therein and of all property whether personal real or mixed which hereafter may be in any manner acquired by her and further that from the date of these presents henceforth and forever he will not in any manner with intent let or hinder or in anywise control or attempt to control or receive any right or claim of any nature or kind over or toward her or any property now in her possession or that she may hereafter acquire. And the said party of the second part does hereby solemnly covenant promise and agree to and with said party of the first part that she does hereby forever from the date of these presents henceforth and forever abandon and relinquish all right and claim of whatever nature or kind to the care and support or protection of the said party of the first part and of any and all property of any kind which the said party of the first part may hereafter acquire. And it is mutually agreed that in case a divorce is granted in a suit now pending between said parties that the decree of said Court in relation to the common property shall be in conformity with the terms of this

Agreement in lieu of Alimony and counsel fees asked for in said suit by said party of the second part.
