Water Right Location Notice.

Notice is hereby given that I the undersigned Thomas Hooey of Eureka County State of Nevada do hereby locate and appropriate all the water now running issuing and flowing or which may hereafter issue or flow or run from that certain Spring situated in the County of Eureka and State of Nevada and particularly described as being located about one half (1/2) mile Southwesterly from the Spring known as the Frank May Spring on the East side of the road leading from the town of Eureka to Secret Canyon, and about four (4) miles from the town of Eureka, and being about 1/4 mile from the summit of the mountain on the north side. Said Spring was discovered and located by me on or about the 15th of October 1873 and is known as the "Hooey Spring". I claim the right to divert and conduct the water from said Spring to any accessible point by means of Ditches Flumes or other appliances in accordance with the laws of this State to be complied with hereafter and the rights and privileges which are guaranteed to first appropriators of water. I further claim and do hereby locate and appropriate a sufficient quantity of the Public Domain in and about said Spring for the convenient use and enjoyment of the right herein claimed.
