To all whom it may concern.

This is to certify that I have this the 1st day of November 1873 located and claimed the Pond or Old river Channel of the Humboldt river at Palisade, Eureka County and State of Nevada and known as Hogle's ice pond and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point known as the town crossing of the old channel by the Pacific railroad track and extending up said old river bed or channel to a point (100) one hundred feet above the grade made by said Hogle for the purpose of removing ice from said pond.
