Know all men by these presents that I, E. J. Burns do hereby agree to convey to J. O. Gorman all my right title and interest in and to all that certain lot piece or parcel of land situated in the town of Eureka Eureka Co. State of Nevada particularly described as follows. to wit. Lot Number Eight (8) in Block Number Seventeen (17) of the Mc Lory Survey of the town Eureka Eureka County State Nevada together with improvements thereon consisting of Frame House 16 feet by 34 ft with wood house attached, any time within the next six months that is to say before the sixth day of June Eighteen Hundred & Seventy six, on the payment to me by the said J. O. Gorman of the sum of six hundred & fifty dollars (\$650.00) U.S. Gold with interest thereon from this date until paid at the rate of 5 per cent per month.
