

J. S. Ray | Notice of Mining Location

To all whom it may concern, Notice is hereby given that J. S. Ray have this day located and claim fifteen hundred feet along this ledge lode or deposit to be known and called the Jackson Mine together with all dips spurs angles and variations belonging to or appertaining to said ledge lode or deposit, this notice is deposited in a stone monument which monument is situated on the ledge and I claim four hundred feet North and Eleven hundred feet South from this monument together with one hundred and fifty feet on each side of this ledge or lode for working and building purposes this monument situated about eighteen feet from the monument or ledge to a Pine tree blazed Eureka Mining District recently known as Antelope District Eureka Co. Nev. this first day of January 1876.
