Articles of Agreement made and entered into this 15th day of April the 1876, at Ceneka, town and County, State of Nevada,
By and between E. W. Hamilton party of the first part herein
and George A. Sayre, party of the second part being of the first part is the owner and has the entire

control of a certain judgment, now of record, rendered by R. H. Breely, the then Justice of the Peace of Ceneka township in Ceneka County, State of Nevada, on the 22nd day of June 1870
1870 due \$100000 eight hundred and seventy four, in favor of one John Drew, and
against the said George A. Sayre for the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, interest and
costs of the suit, the said party of the first part in consideration of the aforesaid judgment
and agreements made hereafter by the said party of the second part doth hereby
convent, promise and agree, that he, the said party of the first part will have the
executive and proceeding hereunder in the said case of Drew vs. Sayre stayed and have
no order or further proceedings instituted and do or have done or do in any manner try
or file of said judgments or in any further or other way attempt to collect the amount or
any part thereof, due upon said judgments or have the same done by any person acting
for him prior to the 20th day of May, A.D. 1876. And the said party of the second part in consideration
of the foregoing promises, covenants and agreements, made by the said party of the first part doth
hereby convention promise and agree that he will pay or before the said twentieth day of May
1876 pay over to the said party of the first part the sum of one hundred and fifty
gold coin dollars, provided always that the said sum shall be obtained by the said party of the
second part from the net proceeds of the working of the Little Rose and Big But mines or either of
them, situated on the "Big Mountain" in Ceneka Mining District, Ceneka County, State of Nevada,
in sum the proceeds arising from the sale and conveyance of said Little Rose and Big But mines, on
either of them, which is further mutually agreed between the parties hereto that this agreement shall
be performed by the covenants made hereby the said parties, and shall be totally null and void
from and after the said twentieth day of May 1876 unless complied with fully and before and day
to the strict and faithful performance of which the said parties do hereby bind themselves, their and
each of their heirs, administrators executors or assigns jointly. In testimony whereof the said
parties have signed and set their hands and affixed their seals, this the 13th day of April A.D. 1876
