Know all men by these Presents.

That I, R J Jones, of the County of Eureka,
Nevada, the party of the first part, for and in
consideration of the sum of Three thousand
five hundred (\$3500) dollars gold coin of the United States of America
to him in hand paid by D Manheim James Kenedy and Geo Jones
of the same place the parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and conveyed and
by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said parties
of the second part their executors administrators and assigns, full and
entire personal property belonging to the said party of the first part and
situated on the ranch heretofore purchased by said party of the first part
of Gray & Walrod and also on the ranch known as Lone Mountain ranch
situated about 18 miles N W of Eureka, and consisting in all of about
6000 bushels of Charcoal, 8 eight horses & harness for same, 3 wagons
also 190 sacks Coal, 300 Coal sacks and all tools and all other
personal property on said two (2) ranches in possession of & belonging
to said party of the first part of whatever kind or description.

To have and to hold the same to the said parties of the second part
their executors administrators and assigns forever and I do for myself
and my heirs executors and administrators covenant and agree to and
with the said party of the second part their executors administrators
or assigns to warrant and defend the sale of the said property, goods
and chattels hereby made unto the said party of the second part their
heirs executors administrators and assigns against all and every
person and persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
