Release from an undertaking
upon injunction.

Whereas in a certain action
in the District Court of Eureka
County Nevada in which W. S. Baird was Plaintiff
and Maginni and others were Defendants an
injunction was issued in favor of said Plaintiff
and against the Defendants injuncting them from
the commission of certain acts in said injunction
order more particularly enumerated, in which
action and as a condition precedent to the
issuance of said injunction an undertaking was
filed for the costs and damages which the said
defendants might sustain by reason of said
injunction, in case the Court should finally
decide that the Plaintiff was not entitled thereto,
and whereas said action was subsequently
dismissed and said injunction was dissolved
and a right of action thereby having accrued up

said undertaking in favor of said Defendants against
the said obligors therein named W. W. McLoary and Suther
Clark.

Now therefore in consideration of the sum of Four
Hundred Dollars lawful money of the United States
to us in hand paid by W. W. McLoary and Suther Clark
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged we do hereby
acknowledge full and complete satisfaction upon said
undertaking, and hereby discharge said W. W. McLoary
and Suther Clark from all liability of any kind
or nature accruing or to accrue thereon, as fully
and to all intents and purposes as though said
undertaking had never been executed by them.
