Whereas the above named Plaintiff did come into said Court on the 15th day of June A.D. 1876 and there and there have his complaint filed wherein he sets forth that the above named defendant is indebted to him in the sum of Forty six  $\frac{60}{100}$  coin dollars due on acct for goods wares and merchandise sold and delivered by Plaintiff to defendant, also Forty  $\frac{25}{100}$  coin dollars due on acct which is duly assigned to Plaintiff in writing by B Berg for merchandise sold and delivered to defendant by said Berg also, Sixty seven  $\frac{32}{100}$  on acct which is assigned to Plaintiff in writing by one J B Lockwood for hardware sold and delivered by Lockwood to Defendant and for dress making done by Mrs Lockwood for defendant making in all the sum of One hundred & fifty four  $\frac{27}{100}$  coin dollars U.S Gold

And Plaintiff thereupon had a summons issued and placed in the hands of Constable D R Kelly for service, the summons being directed to the said defendant M P Murphy, and made returnable on the 17th day of June A.D. 1876 at 10

o'clock AM; And whereas on this 17th day of June AD 1876, comes the Plaintiff into Court and asks that the case be continued until the 20th day of June AD 1876 at 10 o'clock PM, and whereas on this 20th day of June AD 1876 said Constable returns said summons endorsed "served upon the said defendant M Murphy on the 15th day of June AD 1876 at Eureka Township and County by delivering to him a true copy of the original summons, summons as returned filed.

And at the hour set for trial comes the Plaintiff into Court and having with the Court one full hour, to wit: 20: clock PM, of this day and Defendant having wholly failed to appear or answer in this action Plaintiff moves that his default be entered as above. "So directed"

And J C Sockwood and B Berg are sworn on behalf of Plaintiff and do testify and prove the assignments to Plaintiff of their claims in due form And Plaintiff moves for judgment against said defendant for sum claimed by default And the default having been entered it is so ordered. Now therefore in view of the law and foregoing facts it is hereby ordered considered and adjudged that the said Plaintiff A Berg have and receive of and from the said Defendant M Murphy the full and complete sum of One hundred and fifty four <sup>(22)</sup>/<sub>100</sub> gold coin dollars together with costs of this suit taxed at ten coin dollars as for Cost bills filed and have this his judgment therefore and the whole thereof
