



Know all men by these presents, that John Hannan, Charles Cramer of Ceneka, Ceneka County, Nevada, party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars, gold coin of the United States to him in hand paid by John Hannan, of the same place, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold to the said party of the second part the following personal property to wit:

The bar fixtures, tables, chairs stoves lamps pictures, mirrors cooking utensils bedding and all liquors beers cigars excepting one barrel of of whiskey which belongs to party of the first part, which are now contained in the St Louis Brewery and Bakery; also the woodshed and the wood therein and the axes and shovels. This sale is intended to include all the fixtures in and about the said premises belonging thereto

To have and to hold the same, to the said party of the second part, his administrators and assigns forever warranting and defending the sale of said property goods and chattels hereby made to said party of the second part against all and every persons or persons who-soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
