

Caroline Lorenz } Sole Trader.

In the District Court of the Sixth Judicial District of the State of Nevada, in and for the County of White Pine.

In the matter of the application of Mrs Caroline Lorenz for permission to transact business in her own name and upon her own account as a Sole Trader.

This application came on to be heard, in open court, on the 16th day of September AD 1876 and was continued until the 18th day of September AD 1876 and from the testimony offered by the applicant the Court finds the following facts. That due notice of said application was published for four successive weeks commencing on the 19th day of August AD 1876 and ending on the 18th day of September AD 1876 in the "White Pine News," a public newspaper printed and published at Hamilton in said County. That said Caroline Lorenz is a married woman and the wife of Henry Lorenz a resident of White Pine County and State aforesaid that for some time past the said Henry Lorenz has contributed but little to the support of the said Caroline Lorenz and her children, That said applicant is a resident of White Pine County, Nevada, and that it is her intention to engage in the business of vegetable and stock raising also buying and selling and dealing in real and personal estate in the County and State aforesaid in her own name and on her own account and that she is dependant upon her own exertions for her maintenance and support as well as that of her children, And the said applicant having taken the oath prescribed by law now, therefore it is ordered that said applicant be authorized and empowered to carry on business in her own name and on her own account but to engage in vegetable and stock raising also buying and selling and dealing in real and personal estate under and by virtue of the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of the State of Nevada, entitled "An Act to authorize married women to transact business in their own names as Sole Traders, Approved Feb'y 6th AD 1867 Given under my hand in Open Court this 18th day of September AD 1876
