Eureka Nev Dec 9 1876.

R H Glassford and C W Turner, This transfer is for the purpose of securing to Mr Gillem a running ap which Gillem has against me. Should Gillem make a sale of the above mentioned property and the receipt of monies received by him should exceed the amount of my indebtedness to him he is to place the balance to my credit. Should the amount received fail to liquidate the amount that I am indebted to Gillem the balance is to be charged to me on ap.
