 (Disclaimer)

Whereas the undersigned John & Plater of Eureka County State of Nevada did in the month of April a D 1877 construct a certain wagon road in the southern portion of the town of Eureka, said road being more particularly described as the road leading from the Jackson Company's furnace site to the furnaces of the said Plater, known as the Atlas furnaces, and whereas the bed of said road is laid upon and covers, seventy five feet more or less of the land owned and occupied by the said Jackson Mq Company, Now Therefore the object and purpose of this instrument voluntarily executed by said Plater is to forever deny that the said Plater has now or ever had any right title or interest in and to the seventy five feet of land herein specified and that he only enjoys the use thereof by consent of said Jackson Mining Company for the purposes of said road and for no other purpose and that he the said Plater will discontinue to occupy and use the said seventy five feet of land whenever the said Jackson Mining Company or its Agent shall so demand. In token whereof the above named Plater has hereunto set his hand and seal this Seventeenth day of April a D 1877.
