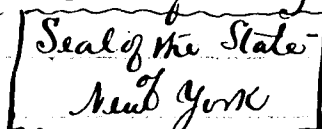


Joseph H. Lukens } Medical Diploma

Incorporated by Special Act of the Legislature April 22 1865



Be it known to all and everywhere

That Joseph H. Lukens, has been duly recommended by the Censors of the Eclectic Medical College of the City of New York as an eminent practitioner of medicine worthy of our honorable recognition. We therefore the Trustees of said Corporation by virtue of the authority vested in us by the Legislature of the State of New York do accordingly confer upon him the honorary degree of Doctor of Medicine with all the rights, privileges, immunities and attributes of physicians as declared by the Statutes of this Commonwealth and Country and of the laws of civilized nations. In testimony of the conferment of this degree we present to the person herein named this diploma of the College duly certifying the same and attesting by the seal of the corporation and by the signatures of the President and Secretary a majority of the Board of Censors and of instructors in said Institution.

Dated upon the day of conferment by the order of the Board of Trustees this 28th day of January in the Year Eighteen Hundred and Seventy five.
