Notice of Location of $\frac{3}{4}$ Springs by A. Falkner $\frac{3}{4}$ State of Nevada ^{Yes.}
County of Esmeralda

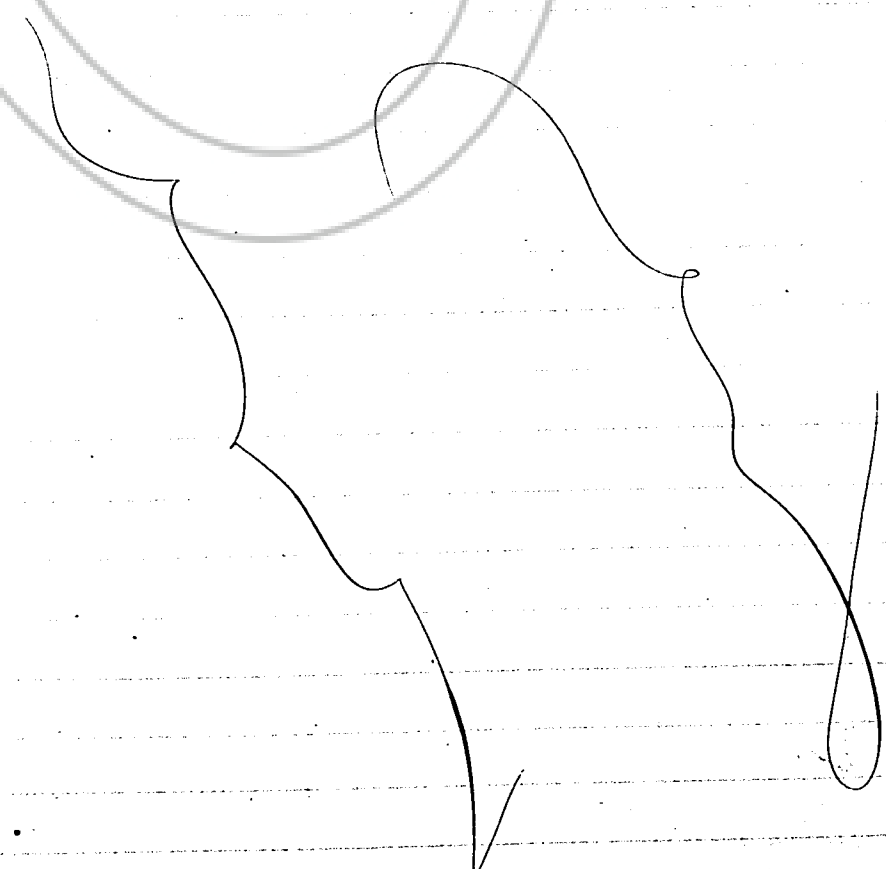
Notice is hereby given that S. A. Falkner of the County of Esmeralda State of Nevada do hereby locate claim and appropriate all of the water now remaining issuing and flowing or which may hereafter issue or flow from those certain springs, (said springs being all within a few yards of each other) situated about thirty miles south westerly from the Town of Esmeralda County and State aforesaid and more particularly known as the source of Birch Creek, on which is situated Falkner Ranch on the west side of East Top Valley in Birch Creek canon and known as the Birch Creek Springs and said Springs were discovered by me on or about the 6th day of April A.D. 1872 and have dug a cut to said Springs I claim the right to direct and conduct the water from said Springs to any accessible point by means of ditches flumes and other appliances in accordance with the laws of the State of Nevada to be complied with, hereafter and the rights and privileges which are guaranteed to your appropriators of water. I further claim and do hereby appropriate and locate a sufficient quantity of the Public Domain in and about said Springs for the convenient use and enjoyment of the rights herein claimed.
