Gray his executors, administrators, or assigns; for which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves heirs, executors and administrators and assigns firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated the 30th day of June A.D. One Thousand eight hundred and seventy seven. The Condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden obligors shall as soon as they shall have procured a United States Patent therefor, make execute and deliver unto said W. H. Gray (Provided that the said W. H. Gray shall on or before that time have paid to the said obligors the sum of one Dollar, the price by said W. H. Gray agreed to be paid therefor) a good and sufficient conveyance of all that certain lot piece or parcel of land situate, lying, and being in the County of Eureka and State of Nevada and bounded and particularly described as follows to wit, Beginning at the North east corner of U.S. Survey No 117. What is called the Williamsonburg Lode, the same being post No 2 of said survey and running thence North 10 1/2° west 200 feet to the S. E. corner or Post No (3) of said Survey, thence North 78 1/2° west (27 1/2) feet thence North 11 1/2° East 200 feet and thence South 78 1/2° East 27 1/2 feet to the place of beginning This is a tract of land embracing 27 1/2 feet of the eastern end of U.S. Survey No 117. What is known and called the Williamsonburg Lode, corners surveyed from the true meridian with a magnetic variation 16 1/2° East.
