Do Alexander G. McHenry of the County and
Geo F. Bragg | County of Eureka and State of Nevada
am held and firmly bound unto George
F. Bragg of the City and County of San Francisco and State of
California in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars gold coin
of the United States to be paid to the said George F. Bragg
his executors administrators or assigns for which payment well
and truly to be made, I bind myself, my heirs, executors and admin-
istrators firmly by these presents, Sealed with my seal and
dated this Twenty seventh day of October A. D. One thousand
Eight hundred and seventy seven. The condition of the above
obligation is such that whereas, the above bounden obligor is
the legal owner and holder and is now in possession and lawfu-
lly entitled to the possession of that certain mine, mining claim or
location known as and called the "California" situated on the
East side of Prospect Mountain in the Eureka Mining District in
said County of Eureka and State of Nevada and whereas
there has been some conflict of title to the said mining claim or
location between the said obligor and obligee which has been
amicably adjusted and settled between them and whereas the
said above bounden obligor is about to apply to the Government
of the United States for a patent to said mining ground, claim
or location. Now the condition of this obligation is such that
if the above bounden obligor, shall within one year from the date
hereof or immediately upon receiving such patent, provided the same
be issued by the Government of the United States at any time before
the expiration of one year from this date, make, execute, acknowledge
and deliver unto the said George F. Bragg (hereinafter that the said

George P. Parag shall on or before the expiration of said one year or upon the issuance of said patent for said mining ground or claim pay to the said obligor one half of the costs and expenses of procuring said patent not to exceed the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars for the one half of said costs or expenses, and shall further enter on protest nor file nor make any objection to the application of said obligor for said patent) in good and sufficient conveyance with the usual covenants for the full undivided one half of said mining ground or claim or for the full undivided one half part of the said mining ground to the said obligor may obtain from the Government of the United States by the issuance of the patent aforesaid then this obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force, words and effect
