Pearson have this day and do hereby sell assign transfer and set over to James Baricklow for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars in U.S. Gold coin to me in hand paid by him and hereby receipted for. All my right title and interest of in and to a certain judgment purchased by me from Henry Street and William Wermouth on March 28<sup>th</sup> 1873 in the Town of Nevada County of Lander and State of Nevada, and which judgment was reversed by said Street and Wermouth against the Phoenix Silver Mining Company of said last named town county and State in the District Court of the 6<sup>th</sup> Judicial district in and for said town, county and State on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of February 1873 for the sum of \$11,411<sup>15</sup> gold coin and \$99<sup>25</sup> cents with interest thereon from Feb 1<sup>st</sup> 1873 at 10 per cent per annum in like gold coin and which judgment was docketed & Recorded March 31. 1873 at 9. A. M. of that day in Lib 2 Miscellaneous Records of said Lander County and State
