Lease.

This Indenture made this Second day of November
A.D. 1877 by and between Thomas Wetherell of Eureka
County State of Nevada, the party of the first part
and James Allen and John T. Calvert of the same
County and State the parties of the second part Witnesseth: That
for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein-
after contained on the part of the second parties, the first party has
leased let and demised unto the second parties the following described
Mines and Mining claims for the full period of six months
from the date hereof, That is to say. The Tip Top Mine and the
Commut Mine both of which mines are situated on the Western slope
of Prospect Mountain near the summit in Eureka Mining District
Eureka County, Nevada. To have and to hold the same together with
all tools implements and appurtenances now thereon during the
full period of this lease, and it is further understood and mutually
agreed between the parties hereto, that in consideration of the said second
parties taking this lease and working at least two men constantly on
said leased premises that they the second parties are to have all the
ore extracted therefrom subject however to the following express
understanding. That in case a considerable body of ore is struck
in either of said Mines during the continuance of this lease there
it shall be optional with the first party to have the same remain
in the mine in place and pay in coin or in such manner as
the parties hereto may agree upon, such sum or sums as no disinter-
ested Miners may say such body of ore would be worth to the
second parties if the same were extracted one of said referees to be
chosen by each party to this lease, and if said two referees can not
agree they shall choose a third referee and he shall decide between
them and the said second parties agree to work constantly on
said Mines unavoidable causabiy excepted with at least 2 men, and
to work said mines in a good and miners like manner and not to
gouge the same and to quit and surrender up the possession of the
said property to the first party at the termination of this lease in
as good condition as it now is, ordinary working, and extraction of
ore and the ware and tools thereby excepted and it is further agreed
that the said second parties shall not be bound to work on said

Mines for the full period of six months but may quit the same if after trial they shall deem it expedient to work longer but in that case shall forfeit the work done under this lease but the second parties shall have the privilege of the full six months if they so choose.
