Eureka Nevada Oct 6<sup>th</sup> 1875. Received by the hand of Daniel Morgan of (Eureka Nevada) from W. W. Mc Coy. Nine hundred (\$900<sup>00</sup>%) Dollars in full payment for all claims or demands of whatever kind against the possessary claim of said Morgan on which we now reside, it being understood that said Morgan make a reservation of Two hundred (200) feet square for our use and on which our improvements are situated. Said possessary claim was located March 25<sup>th</sup> 1873. and is recorded - Book A. of Surveys page 1. records of Eureka County. It is understood that said Mc Coy shall have the right to dig ditches or excavate for water purposes provided when he has finished he fill them in such a way as not to incumber us. Said reservation of Two (200) hundred is according to a Survey made by E. J. Fine Oct 5<sup>th</sup> 1875 In Witness Whereof we hereto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and year first above written
