

Agreement

Jacob Allison
A. P. Jones

This is to certify that we the undersigned
Jacob Allison, party of the first part and A. P.
Jones party of the second part, both residents
of Eureka County, State of Nevada have this
day hereunder and agreed, to wit, That I Jacob Allison, party of
the first part agree to lease or Rent to A. P. Jones party of
the second part the undivided One half of my Ranch situated
on the West side of Antelope Valley and known as Allison's Ranch
Together with one half interest in all the farming implements
and farm houses to work the same for and in consideration
of which, I A. P. Jones party of the second part agree to pay
unto Jacob Allison one or before the twentieth day of December
1877. One thousand eight hundred and seventy seven and
of Five Hundred & 51/2 Dollars in Gold coin. It is further
understood and agreed by Jacob Allison party of the first part
that if said A. P. Jones party of the second part does truly and
faithfully pay the said Five Hundred dollars, as above agreed
to the said A. P. Jones may continue to possess and hold
his lease to the undivided One half of said Ranch for the
sum One Thousand eight hundred and seventy eight dollars
in consideration of which said A. P. Jones agrees to pay the
said Jacob Allison one or before the twentieth day of December
One thousand eight hundred and seventy eight. The sum of
Five hundred and fifty Dollars in gold coin. It is further

agreed by Joe Allison party of the first part that if said
 A. F. Jones truly and faithfully pay said six Hundred &
 fifty dollars as agreed to that the said A. F. Jones may continue
 to possess and hold this house to said undivided One half
 of said Ranch for the year One thousand eight hundred and
 seventy nine, for and in consideration of which I. A. F. Jones
 party of the second part agrees to pay to Joe Allison the
 sum of Eight Hundred Dollars in Gold Coins, it is further
 agreed & covenanted by said Joe Allison, party of the first
 part, that of said A. F. Jones party of the second part does
 well and truly make the foregoing three payments as agreed
 to and shall further pay unto the said Joe Allison on or
 before the first day of January eighteen hundred and eighty
 (1880) the sum of One Thousand five hundred and fifty
 Dollars. If so said Joe Allison covenanted and
 agrees to make and execute unto A. F. Jones his heirs &
 assigns as Deed to the undivided One half of said Ranch
 together with One half interest in all the houses and cattle
 now owned by me all of which cattle and houses are bounded
 with quarter circles A (A) together with all the increase
 from the present date until said first day of January 1880
 One thousand eight hundred and eighty, it is further agreed
 and covenanted by the said A. F. Jones party of the second part
 that if I do not faithfully comply with all of the foregoing
 promises or obligations as agreed to I will on failing so to do
 I will quietly remove myself and family with all my effects
 from off said Ranch and leave said Joe Allison or his heirs
 and assigns in full and peaceful possession thereof.
