Agreement

For and in consideration of the sum of (\$300⁰⁰)
Three Hundred Dollars Gold coin and interest thereon
at the rate of four percent, per month from the date
hereof for the term of six calendar months. This day
loaned to me by A. Benedict, A. E. Titus, R. J. Mc Donnell
and S. Cooper and as security for the payment of
the said sum of \$300⁰⁰ and the said interest thereon. I hereby sell assign
transfer & set over to the said A. Benedict A. E. Titus R. J. Mc Donnell
and S. Cooper that certain Bond made and executed by the said A.
Benedict A. E. Titus R. J. Mc Donnell & S. Cooper as parties of the
1st part and in favor of Marshall Atwood party of the second part
for the sum of (\$3000⁰⁰) Three thousand Dollars Gold coin to be
paid when the Bald Eagle Mine is sold or when the net proceeds of said
Mine amount to \$50,000⁰⁰ and recorded in the Recorders office of Eureka
County Nevada on the 16th day of October 1876 in "Book A. Miscellaneous"
of the records of said County on Page 366. & 367 provided that if at
any time before the expiration of the said six months I repay to the
said A. Benedict A. E. Titus R. J. Mc Donnell and S. Cooper the said
sum of \$300⁰⁰ and the interest then thereon accrued, then this instrument
is to be void. but in case the said sum of \$300⁰⁰ and interest as
aforesaid are not paid at the expiration of six months from the
date hereof then this assignment shall be void and in full satisfaction
for the said \$300⁰⁰ and interest.
