And now on this the 18th day of January A.D. 1878 comes said plaintiff and has filed his complaint wherein he shows to the Court, that there is now due and owing from Defendant to Plaintiff, on account for services rendered and for goods wares and merchandise sold and delivered, the sum of \$264³⁸ - Plaintiff also has filed his affidavit for attachment and an approved undertaking on attachment, in the sum of Two hundred Dollars gold coin with Ed. Looney and Frank Knight as sureties thereto. And thereupon the Court issued Summons and writ of Attachment and placed them in the hands of the Constable of said Eureka Township for service. said summons is made returnable at the hour of One O'clock P.M. on the 22nd day of January A.D. 1878 January 22nd 1878 said summons is returned and filed, and at the hour set for trial, the parties appear. Defendant has filed his answer in which he alleges that he has paid for the goods and Merchandise bought of Plaintiff and that the wages for Plaintiff labor are not by the terms of the contract yet due. The case then proceeded to trial Plaintiff called Abram Laird, S. H. Clark, Lorenz Gorman and Nat. Soule and rested Defendant then moved for a Non-Suit on the ground that Plaintiff had failed to prove that there was any money due from Defendant to Plaintiff. Motion argued and over-ruled. Defendant then called Jo Ravell and J. M. Foley and rested. The case was then argued by the Attorneys and submitted for Judgement. - January 23rd 1878 The Court having well considered the law and the testimony finds for the Plaintiff in the sum of \$240³⁸ and his costs herein. Wherefor it is ordered considered and adjudged by the Court this the 23rd day of January A.D. 1878 that the said Plaintiff do have and recover of and from the said Defendant Jo Ravell, the full and complete sum of Two hundred and Forty & ³⁸/₁₀₀ (240³⁸/₁₀₀) Dollars gold coin and his costs in this action, taxed as per cost Bill filed at 49⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars and have this his Judgement therefor and the whole thereof With legal interest on the same until satisfied. - Witness my hand officially this the 23rd day of January A.D. 1878

Execution issued January the 26th 1878 and given to the constable for service at request of Plaintiffs Attys - Execution returned and filed March 25th 1878 Credited with \$74²⁵/₁₀₀ and charged with accrued costs \$15²⁵/₁₀₀
