Johnson of White Pine County State of Nevada the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars Gold Coin of the United States of America to me in hand paid by James Adams of Eureka County State of Nevada the party of the second part. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs executors administrators and assigns Thirteen Horses harness for ten horses Three wagons and seventy head of stock cattle branded with "J" on the left side and "JV" on left hip and now running on the range of Newark Valley White Pine County State of Nevada To Have and to hold the same to the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns forever And I do for myself heirs executors and administrators, covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part his heirs executors, administrators and assigns, to warrant and defend the sale of the said property goods and chattles hereby made unto the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns against all and every person and persons whatever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the Third day of June in the year of our lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy eight
