

H. R. Kemp & Mary L. Kemp | This Indenture Made the sixth day of November in the year of  
our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy eight witnesseth  
that H. R. Kemp and Mary L. Kemp his wife both of the town of  
Eureka County of Eureka State of Nevada do hereby lease demise  
and let unto Patrick Kane of said town and County the following  
described premises situate on the west side of Main Street in said town of  
Eureka to wit; Lot number five, (5) in Block number eleven (11) according  
to McBoys survey and plat of said town. Said premises to be used for  
the usual purposes of a Hotel and boarding house during the term of this  
lease. Together with all of the appurtenances and fixtures pertaining to  
said premises and the house thereon standing. To have and to hold  
for the term of One year to wit; from the sixth day of November 1878  
to the fifth day of November 1879 at calding and paying therefor the rent  
of One hundred and fifty Dollars monthly gold coin of the United States  
of America, and the said lessee promises to pay the said rent in such  
coin and as follows to wit; Monthly advance on the Sixth day of each  
and every month during the term of this lease and to quit and deliver  
up the premises to the lessors or their agents or attorneys peaceably  
and quietly at the end of the term in as good order and condition (rea-  
sonable use and wear thereof, and damage by the elements excepted) as the  
same are now or may be put into; and to pay the rent as above stated  
during the term; also the rent as above stated for such further time as the  
lessee may hold the same and not make or suffer any waste thereof, nor  
lease or underlet or permit any other person or persons to occupy or improve  
the same, or make or suffer to be made, any alteration therein but with  
the approbation of the lessors thereto, in writing having been first obtained  
and that the lessors may enter to view and make improvements and to  
evict the lessee if he fail to pay the rent as aforesaid or to make or  
suffer any strip or waste thereof; And should default be made in  
the payment of any portion of said rent when due, and for five days  
thereafter, the said lessors their agents or attorneys, may reenter and  
take possession and at their option terminate this lease.
