



Bond for Deed.

Know all Men by these Presents: That we R. Sadler and Patrick Moran of Eureka County State of Nevada are held and firmly bound unto Z. A. Stephenson of said County and State of Nevada in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars, Gold Coin of the United States of America, to be paid to the said Z. A. Stephenson his executors, administrators or assigns; for which payment well and truly to be made, We bind ourselves our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly & severally firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated the 10th day of January A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy nine.

The Condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden obligors shall on the tenth day of April A.D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (or as the mining ground hereinafter mentioned shall be situated) make, execute, and deliver unto the said Z. A. Stephenson (provided that the said Z. A. Stephenson shall on or before that day have paid to the said obligors the sum of Seven Thousand Dollars, the price by said Z. A. Stephenson agreed to be paid therefor,) a good and sufficient conveyance of all those certain lots pieces or parcels of land situate, lying, and being in the Eureka Mining District County of Eureka and State of Nevada and bounded and particularly described as follows, to wit: That certain mining claims situated upon Prospect Mountain and known and recorded as the Delaware Mine, and containing 1000 feet. Also the Orange No One Mine situated upon Prospect Mountain contiguous to said Delaware Mine and containing six hundred feet. Also the Orange No. Two Mine situated on Prospect Mountain contiguous to Orange No. One and containing four hundred feet. Also the Quince Mine situated contiguous to and adjoining the Delaware Mine and containing six hundred feet. Also the Goliah Mine situated contiguous to and adjoining the Delaware Mine and containing eight hundred feet. Also the May Flower Mine situated contiguous to and adjoining the Goliah Mine and containing eight hundred feet. Then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
