Bond for Assignment

Know all Men by these Presents: That We
William Arington and M. P. Battlett of the
Town and County of Eureka, State of Nevada are
held and firmly bound unto John Shoebau of the same place in the
sum of Fourteen thousand two hundred Dollars, gold coin of the United
States of America, to be paid to the said John Shoebau his executors, ad-
ministrators or assigns: for which payment well and truly to be made,
we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, firmly by
these presents: Sealed with our seals and dated the 1st day of March A.D.
one thousand eight hundred and seventy nine.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden
obligors, upon the payment to them of the sum of Eighty thousand dollars
in U.S. & Coin or before the 25th day of May 1879 by the said obligee his
heirs or assigns in accordance with the conditions of a certain agreement made
between the parties hereto bearing date the 16th day of Feb'y 1879, shall assign
unto the said obligee or his assigns those certain bonds now owned by the
obligors: viz 1st That certain bond of Geo. W. Lamourent conditioned for the
conveyance of "Hudson Mine" recorded in Records of Eureka County February
24th 1879 in Miscellaneous p 546 2nd That bond of Geo. W. Lamourent
conditioned for the conveyance of the "Tandebilt Mine" and recorded as
aforesaid on p 543. 3rd That Bond made by Joseph Mendes for the
"Mineral Bluff" Mine, recorded as aforesaid on p 545- 4th That Bond
made by Thomas J Read for the "Disgorge Mine" recorded as aforesaid
on p 544, with their interest in to and under the said instruments then the
above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
