For Value Received We the subscribers of Cureka in the County of Cureka and State of Nevada promise to pay to the order of H. D. Brooks Four hundred and forty Dollars, at Cureka, Nevada, as follows One hundred dollars cash in hand, and Thirty dollars on the first day of September A. D. 1879 and thirty dollars on the first day of each succeeding month untill the whole amount shall be paid with interest on each payment at the rate of ten per cent. per annum. from date hereof. The consideration of the above promissory note is the agreement to sell and the delivery to the signer of one Piano made by W. P. Emerson. Boston. Mass. No 16038 Style 4. by said H. H. Timball, and we agree that in case we make default in the payment of any

installment in said note at the time and place when the same becomes due, the said W. H. Timball or his assigns shall be at liberty to declare the whole sum unpaid due and payable and the said instrument the property of the signer, and to sue for and collect the same with ten per cent. damages for expenses of collection, which we agree to pay, or at his option, to take possession of said instrument and to sell the same at public auction, at some place in said County of Couseka Nevada after giving notice by posting said notice in three public places near the place of sale three days previous thereto, or at private sale without advertisement, to the highest bidder for cash, and out of the proceeds of said sale to pay the unpaid balance of said note and cost of sale, and return the remainder to the signer hereof, by which said sale the title of W. H. Timball, and the entire interest of the signer shall vest in the purchaser, and this note becomes satisfied in full.
